
## **Student Learning Engagement**



With 92% of community partners satisfied with our school-parish relationship and religious celebrations, we are proud to foster a culture of love, service, and faith.

- St. Francis of Assisi Academy achieved an 88.7% acceptable standard in Grade 6 Social Studies PAT, exceeding the provincial average of 68.5% and improving significantly from last year's 79%, highlighting the success of the new curriculum and staff dedication.
- With 82.8% acceptable standards across Grade 9 PAT provincial average by 20.3%, reflecting its commitment to targeted interventions and continuous improvement.
- At St. Francis of Assisi Academy, 81.7% of our students report feeling engaged in their learning, which is just below the provincial average of 83.7%. We are actively working to enhance engagement by tailoring learning experiences to meet the needs of all students, fostering inclusion, providing meaningful feedback, and encouraging student voice to build stronger connections in our school community.
